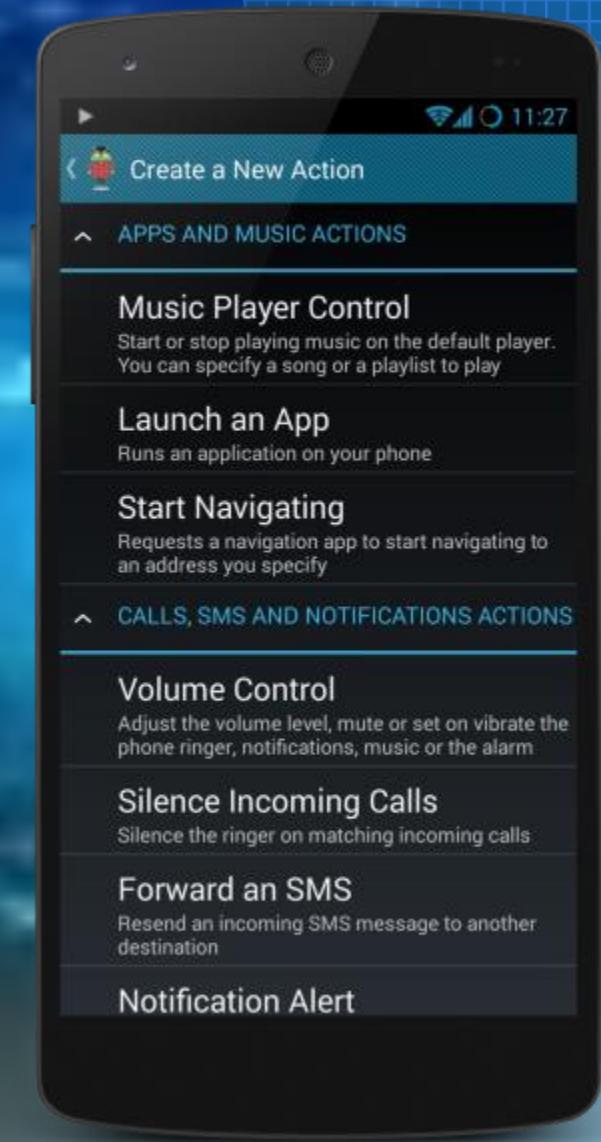
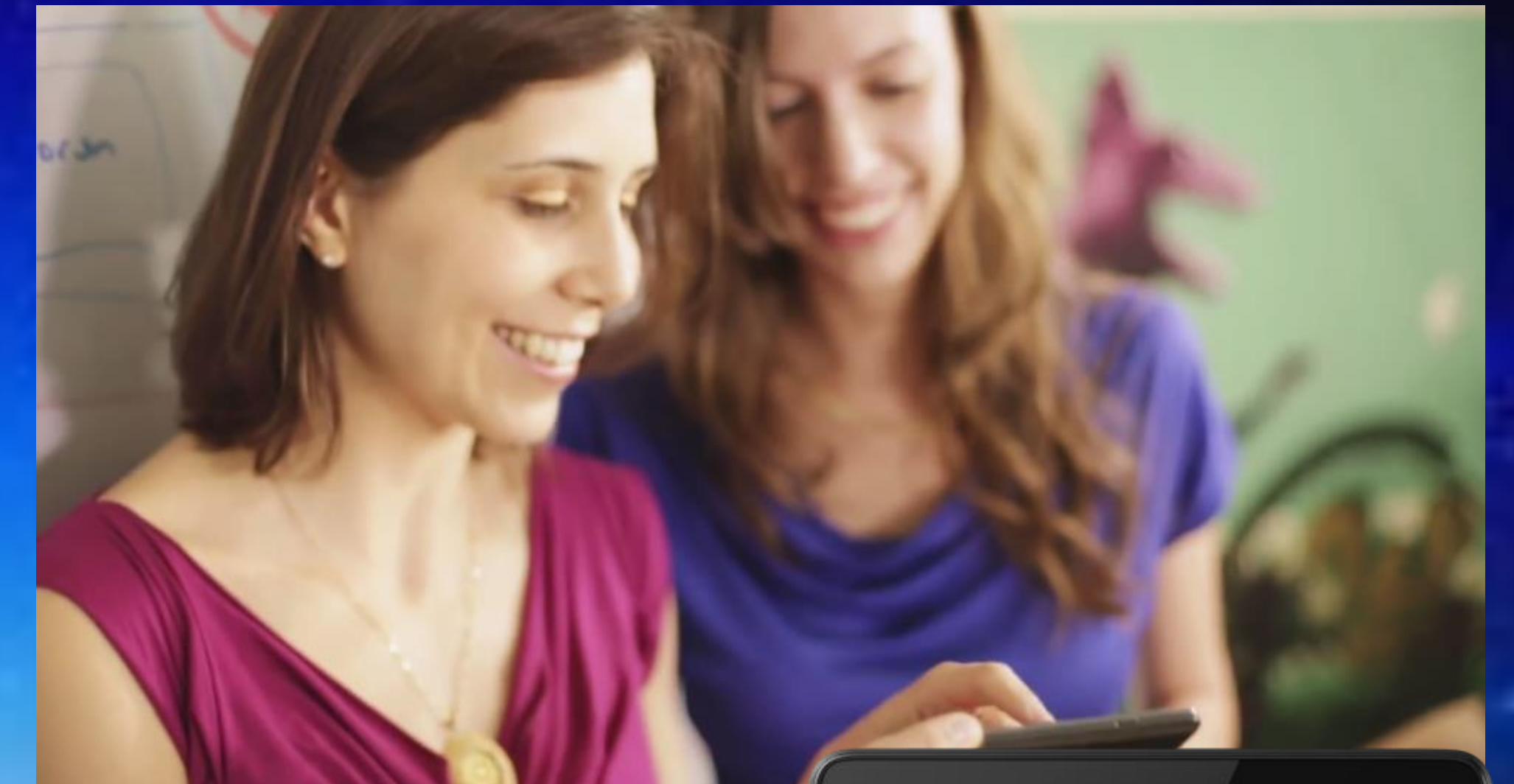


What does it do?

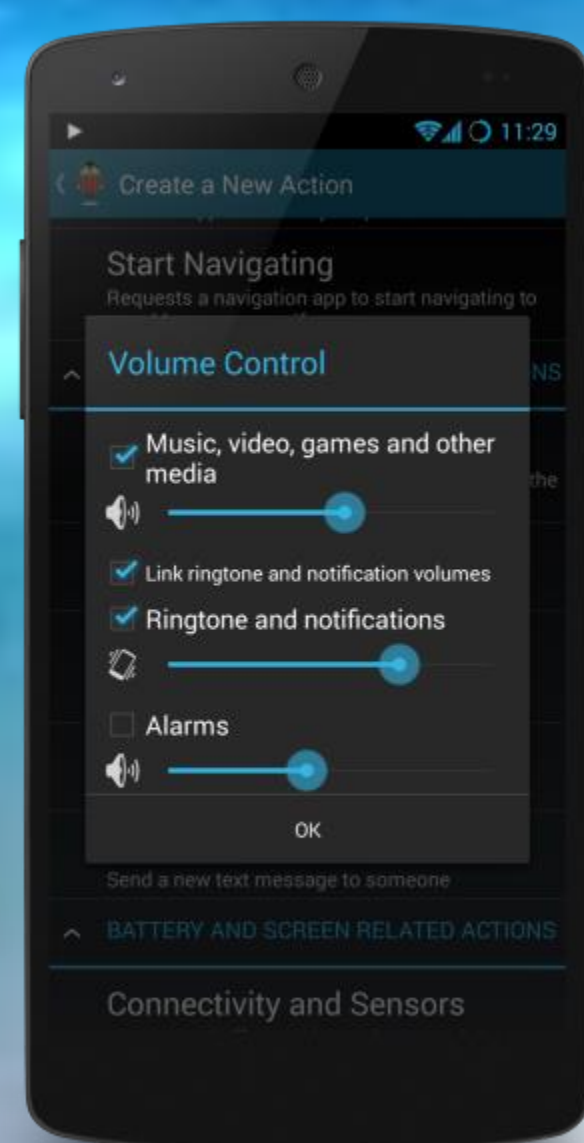
Condi lets you automate common and repetitive tasks on your android.

It's a Do X when Y type of app.

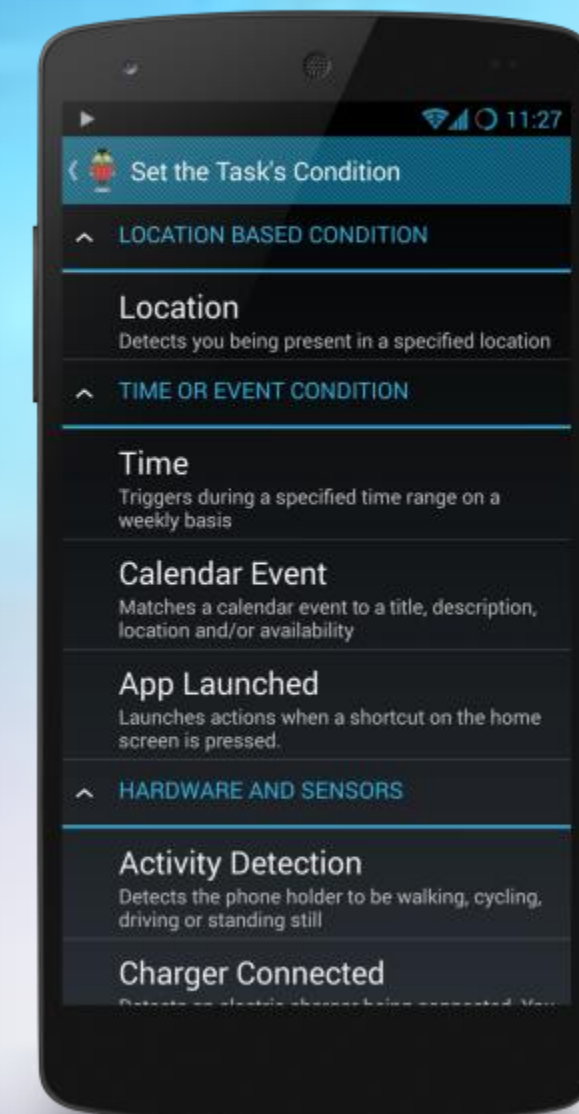
It let's you plan ahead and save yourself the trouble later, like having a reminder that does things for you based on where you are and what you're doing.



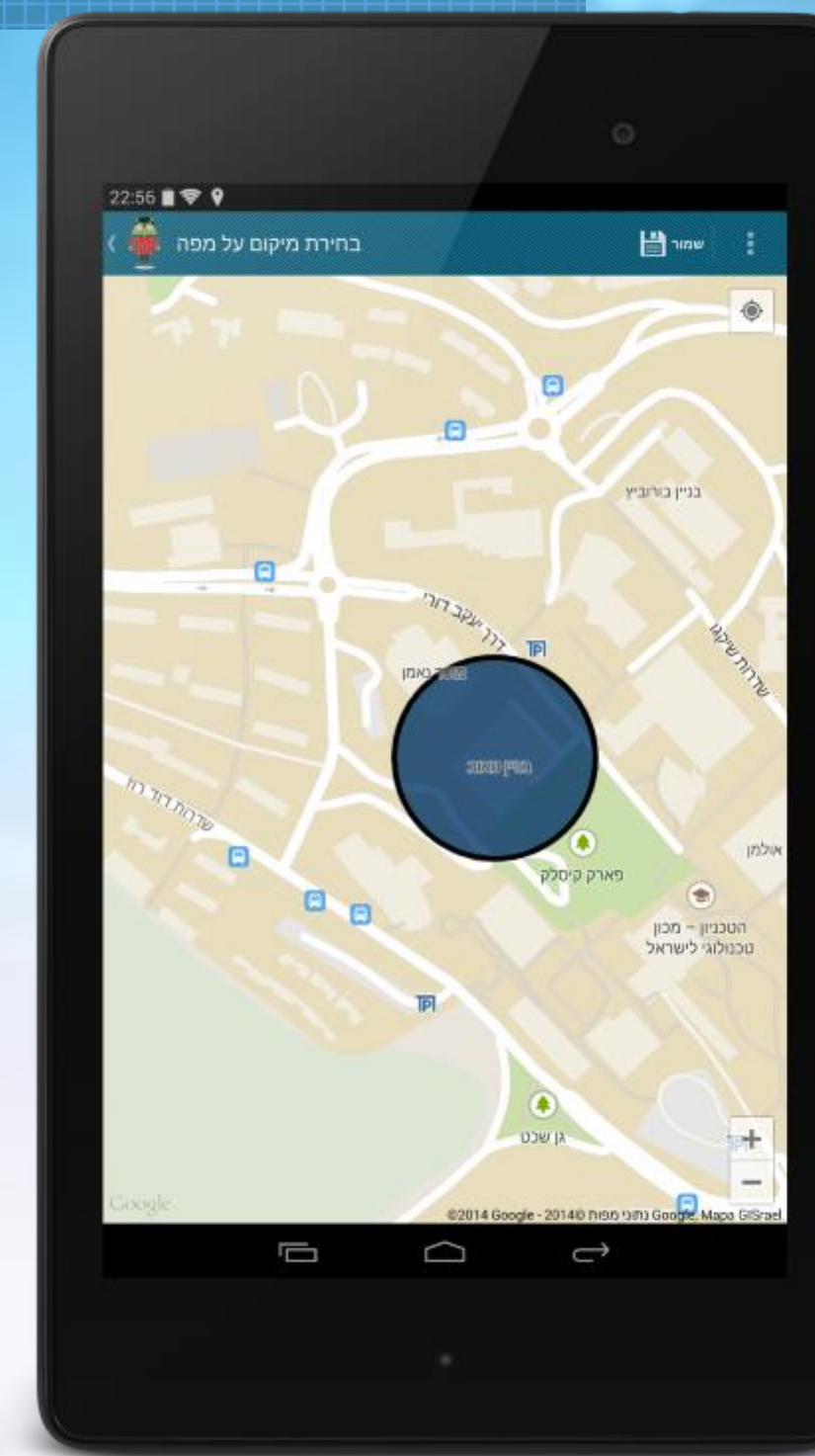
Set a New Action



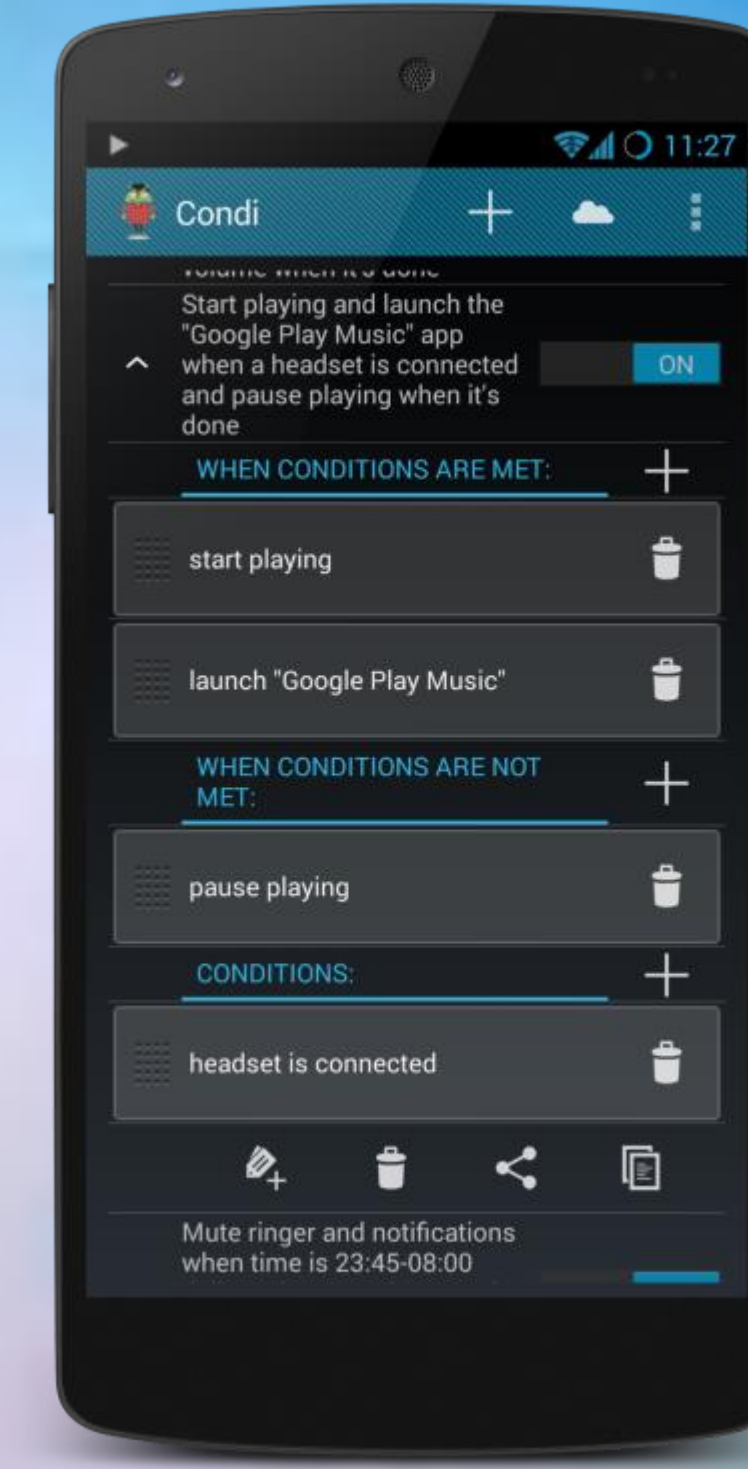
Volume Control Action



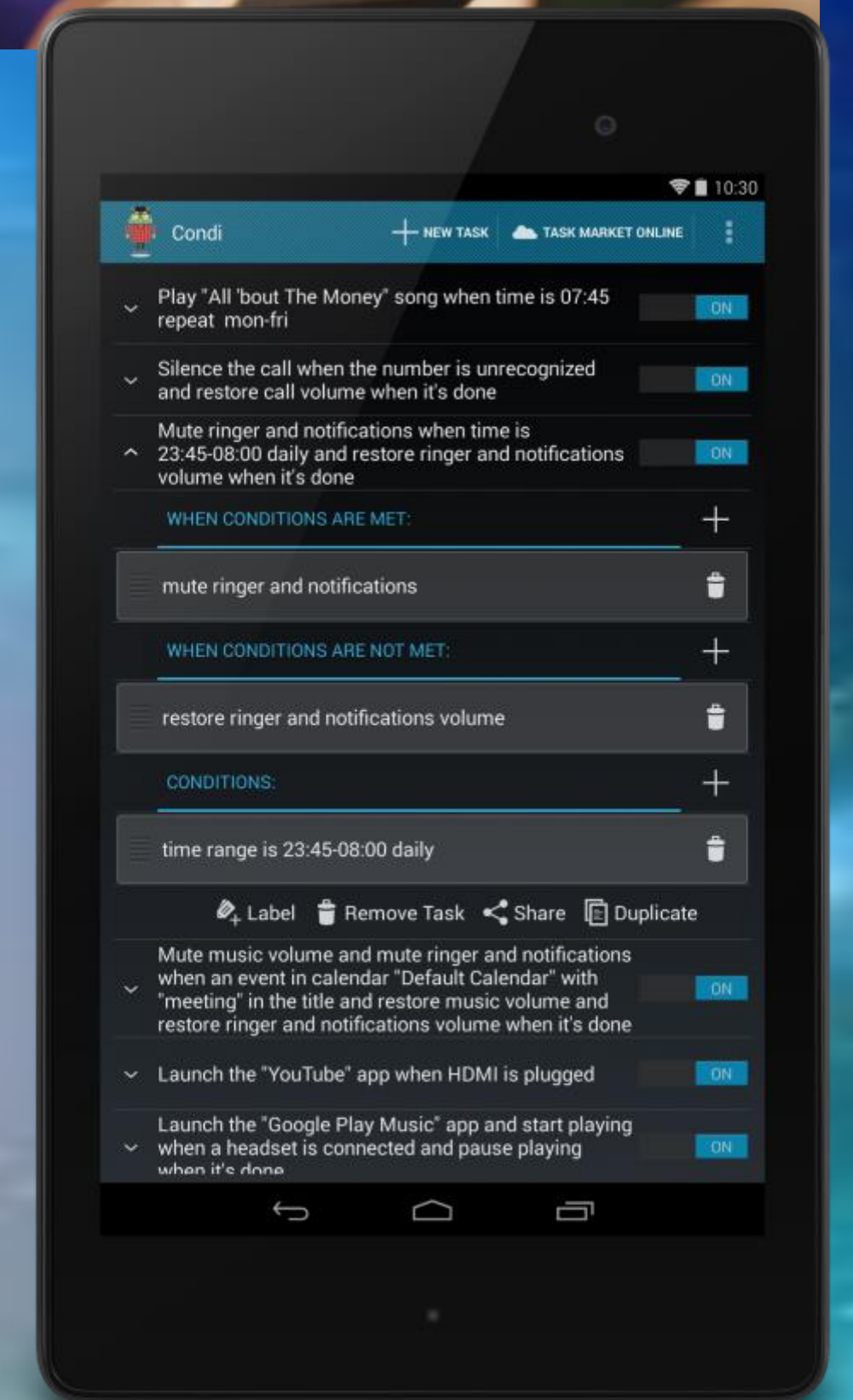
Set a New Condition

What we've done

Condi lets users rapidly create scenarios called "tasks" which include an action and a condition. Tasks can have multiple actions and conditions. Multiple conditions must all be true for the task to run. Duplicate tasks to get the "OR" effect.

Actions can be applied on start or on end of the condition. Most actions have an automatic "restore" action implicitly added.

Tasks are self annotating, requiring minimal user input and no need to pick random names. You can download premade tasks from the web or share your tasks with friends. No social networks or signup required. Sharing is done via regular text messaging apps using normal links.

The app is available in English, Hebrew, Russian, German and Indonesian.

Use cases



Battery's almost dry?

Turn off WiFi, put the brightness down. Back on the charger? Don't forget to undo all that.

Condi let's you easily make a task that runs when battery is low and charger is not plugged.

At the office? Going into class?

Don't forget to mute your phone. Every - single - time. And don't forget to unmute it when you're out. How can we help?

Condi can look up your calendar appointments and silence accordingly.

You can also set a whitelist of callers that will ring regardless.

Oh and you can auto-reply with a text message if you really don't want to be interrupted.

You arrived at your destination. Don't forget to close Waze or your phone's battery will drain. Condi let's you automate this. While we're at it, why not also open Waze when you get behind the wheel.

Oh and start the music player, set the volume level to your car preset, disable screen rotation and restore everything when you're done.

You can also improve your road awareness and safety by muting calls and notifications. It can also auto reply with a canned message.

Think this is all too complicated? Think again.
